#### <u>Literacy</u>:

We love to read in Primary 3! We will continue to focus on developing our fluency and expression when reading aloud, scanning the text for key words. We will also keep working on our comprehension skills by answering a variety of comprehension questions focusing on answering in full sentences.

We will be reading Non Fiction books about 'Weather' and completing a variety of activities related to them.

Our grammar focus will be verbs and speech bubbles. We will revise when to use capital letters and full stops in sentences.

The genre we will be focusing on when writing is <u>'Report'</u>. We will write some lovely reports on Clouds and the Weather! Encourage your child to talk about what they are going to write first - does each sentence make sense? Can I add more detail or use other interesting words? Help your child practice writing at home by giving them opportunities to write freely about any topic that they want! This will develop their creativity skills!

#### Numeracy:

We will continue to learn all about tens and units and we will understand that every place has a value! We will also be learning about Doubles and Near Doubles. We will continue to learn the names of regular **3D shapes** and discuss their properties (faces, edges and corners). We will be learning how to tell the time using quarter past and quarter to.

We will also be developing our Mental Maths skills especially our knowledge of number stories within 20. Keep practicing quick recall of number stories within 20 at home! Don't forget to practice *Partitioning* and *Rounding and Adjusting* too!

We will also keep working on our Problem Solving Skills. This month we are focusing on

'Finding All Possibilities'. Mrs Fleming said we are brilliant problem solvers in Primary 3! Remember to keep using the



Mathletics programme at home too!
