Literacy:

We love to read in Primary 3! We will continue to focus on developing our fluency and expression when reading aloud, scanning the text for key words. We will also keep working on our comprehension skills by answering a variety of comprehension questions focusing on answering in full sentences.

We will be reading Non Fiction books about 'Weather' and completing a variety of activities related to them.

Our grammar focus will be verbs and speech bubbles. We will revise when to use capital letters and full stops in sentences.

We will continue to focus on 'Report' writing. We will write some lovely reports on Clouds and the Weather! We will also write our own weather reports and in our 'I love to write books' we will write some lovely stories about weather.

Encourage your child to talk about what they are going to write first - does each sentence make sense? Can I add more detail or use other interesting words? Help your child practice writing at home by giving them opportunities to write freely about any topic that they want! This will develop their creativity skills!

Numeracy:

We will continue to learn about tens and units and we will focus on adding within 100! We will use our knowledge of tens and units to solve problems and we will be finding the total and giving change within 50p too. We will also be learning how to tell the time using quarter past and quarter to.

We will continue to develop our Mental Maths skills especially our knowledge of number stories within 20 and doubles and near doubles. Keep practicing these facts at home! Don't forget to keep practicing *Partitioning* and *Rounding and Adjusting* too!
We will also keep working on our Problem Solving Skills. This month we are focusing on *'Exploring Patterns and Relationships'*.
We have done some brilliant problem solving so far this year!

Remember to keep using the

Mathletics programme at home too!

World Around Us and The Arts
