### On Your Bike!

It's that time of year again! Time to dust off the cobwebs and get out and about on your bike!

Cycling is a perfect way to stay active as a family, however we must remember the importance of road safety.

During Term Three, our Primary Seven pupils will be given the opportunity to take part in the Cycling Proficiency Scheme. This scheme aims to teach children how to ride their bicycles safely. Lessons (theoretical and practical) will be offered as an after-school activity and children must be able to bring their bike to school. The children will be awarded with a certificate of competence after continuous assessment and a final test. Application/consent forms, with the relevant dates, will be sent home very soon. These MUST be returned to Mrs Gorman (P6) before we break up for Easter holidays.





Introducing our Cashless System: Schoolmoney

We are delighted to be introducing our cashless system after Easter.

Initially, we will use it only for school payments such as break, dinners, school trips, music etc. When we are confident in its use, we will roll it out for Cool Kids. hopefully in time for our summer scheme.

This week you will have been emailed a letter to introduce the system as well as a Welcome text message and email. Please log on and set up your account as soon as possible.

If you have any queries, please contact us in the office.

We really hope this new system will benefit you enormously as parents. You will have the comfort and luxury of paying at home at any time. You will have no more Sunday night looking for cash etc.!

School trip information will be emailed to you via the system. You will pay online as well as give parental permission. This will cut down immensely on the paper needed for notes etc.

Teachers will not be spending up to 1 hour on a Monday morning counting cash etc. so increasing the teaching and learning time for your child.

The online system will act as a receipt for you and for us, so ensuring accurate records at all times.

Dinners MUST be booked in advance: You have up until midnight of the night before to book.

FREE DINNERS MUST ALSO BE BOOKED.

The online system for booking Term 3 dinners in advance is now OPEN.

### Forest School


