World Book Day began with a decree by UNESCO, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization.

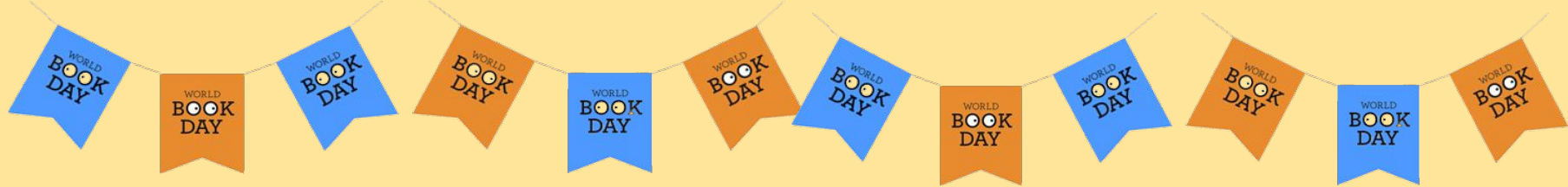
The first World Book Day was held in April 1995 - over 20 years ago!

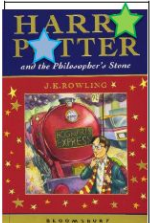
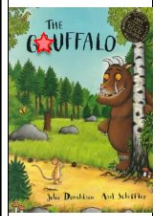
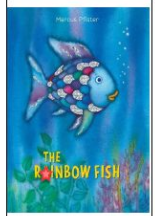
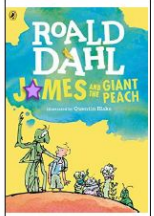
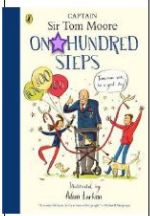
