Cashless System

So far, so good with our new cashless system. Initial reports from parents are that you are really enjoying using this system from the comfort of your own homes....

A few things to remember:

- All dinners MUST be booked online. This includes free dinners as well. Dinners can be booked up until midnight the night before.
- You MUST unbook dinners as well. If you know your child is not going to take a dinner that you have previously booked (maybe they are sick, they want a packed lunch, going on a trup etc), you MUST unbook it on the system. This ensures accurate numbers for Louisa in our canteen
- If your child receives free dinners and is going on a school trip and you would like him/her to receive a free packed lunch, this MUST be booked at least one week before the trip so that we can order this from the canteen.
- On initial logging into the system, you should change your password to something more memorable so that it is easier to use in the future.
- School trip information details, payment and parental consent will all be sent through school money. It is extremely important that parental consent is ticked, otherwise your child may not be able to participate.
