#### 2016/2017 A Memorable Year for St. Joseph's!

As we approach the end of the academic year it is timely to reflect on the past year in St. Joseph's Primary School.

This year has been a very busy year in school. We began the post-inspection process with the development of six post-inspection action plans. The Education and Training Inspectorate carried out its Interim Follow-Up Visit in December 2016 and was extremely positive about the improvements made. The school's rigorous monitoring process has identified the improvements made in Literacy, Numeracy and ICT and this has been confirmed by the school's very positive Literacy and Numeracy data this month which you as parents have received this month in your child's annual report. Recent surveys of parents, pupils and staff have been very favourable as can be seen in the summary enclosed.

This year has been the most successful year ever in sporting achievements with success in athletics, swimming, camogie, Gaelic football, one wall handball and netball. Congratulations to all those pupils who represented St. Joseph's this year.

One of the highlights of the year was our Primary 7 performance of 'Joseph and his Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat' in May. It was the first time we had staged our annual show in the superb surroundings of Lisburn's Island Hall and we are sure it won't be the last.

St. Joseph's very active Parent Teachers' Association also had their most successful year yet with the total raised so far currently standing at over £9000. As Governors we would like to thank the PTA for their commitment to raising those extra funds for the school and we thank you too for your

generosity in supporting the many events held this year.

This year we said goodbye to 56 Primary 7 pupils with 24 families ending their family ties. We wish them well as their journey takes a different path in post-primary education.

We say goodbye to Mrs Gillian Gowdy in the school office. We would like to thank Gillian for her 9 years of service to St. Joseph's and wish her well for the future.

As Governors we wish to sincerely thank all the staff team in St. Joseph's for their commitment and hard work to secure improvement this year.

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
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
