## **Reporting to Parents**

# **Curriculum Meetings**

Under normal circumstances, we would normally be organising curriculum meetings for each year group. Unfortunately these cannot take place this year. ## PTE/PTM Testing

Children in  $P_3$  –  $P_7$  would normally take PTE and PTM tests in May of last year. These are standardised tests in Literacy and Numeracy. With lockdown, these tests were not administered. As a school we have agreed that these tests will not be administered this term in  $P_4$  –  $P_6$ .  $P_7$  only will take these tests at the end of September ahead of their parent teacher meetings in October. All being well we will resume our normal testsing in May 2021 for  $P_3$  onwards. If you have any queries, please contact Mrs Fleming.

#### **Music Lessons**

Music lessons will continue this year face to face. Children will be taught in groups of two - tutors will teach behind a screen or with visors if parents wish, especially in the case of woodwind instruments. Places will be offered to children in Primary 4 and 5 as well as those children already playing.
