Reading

- Striving to develop a child's interest in reading.
- Shared Reading - big books, e-books
- Guided Reading –
 - ORT, Simple Novels, Fire Flies
 - Reading Log
- Independent Reading – Variety of genre
- Dictionary Work – important to develop children's vocabulary
- Developing comprehension skills and answering in full sentences.
- Punctuation and Grammar related to topics.



Writing

- Variety of forms studied – Cross Curricular
 - Procedural Report Narrative Explanation
 - Recount Exposition Poetry
- Punctuation
- Handwriting - on lines
- Spelling - Complete Spelling Programme , definitions

Focus

Independent writing and a mixture between “phonetically plausible” and correct spelling.

Letter shape, size and formation.



Numeracy

- Lots of practical activity and use of IWB (cubes, counters, shapes etc)
- ✓ More emphasis on building up visual knowledge of 30 array, 50 array, 100 square e.g. add 10 and multiples of 10, number before and after etc
- ✓ Ability to make connections and discuss different ways of solving calculations
- Number
- ✓ Consolidate of Number Stories to 20
- ✓ Place Value to 100
- ✓ Addition and Subtraction within 100 using partitioning
- ✓ Money – finding the total and giving change within £1

Numeracy (Continued)

- Multiplication in Term 3 (2, 5 and 10 times tables and explore the link with division)
- Measures, Handling Data, Shape and Space
- Mathseeds programme
- Problem Solving and Investigations – developing the language of maths (applying knowledge)

Word Problems

- Faced with the problem, 'There are 26 sheep and 10 goats on a boat, how old is the captain?' almost 75% of children aged 7-9 performed an arithmetical operation and gave answers such as 36 without expressing any doubt!
(Puchalska and Semademi 1987)

Mental Maths

- Focus on using a wide range of 5 minute warm up activities, e.g. counting stick, show me cards, squashy boxes, follow me cards, bingo, IWB games etc.
- **7 mental arithmetic strategies (5 for P3)**
 - Counting on and back
 - Rounding and adjusting
 - Partitioning
 - Re-ordering
 - Inverse Operations
- Mental Maths homework sent home every week


ICT
